H1N1 Vaccination Clinic Information

During the week of October 19, 2009, H1N1 nasal spray vaccine (LAIV) will be available **free of charge** at the two Public Health clinics located at 1080 Emeline Ave. in Santa Cruz and at 9 Crestview Dr. in Watsonville, on a walk-in basis. County health clinic services are limited to those who reside in Santa Cruz County. The times LAIV is available are as follows:

Santa Cruz Health Center: Monday through Friday, 8am to 11:30am and 1:00pm to 4:30pm
1080 Emeline Ave. Closed weekends, holidays and on the furlough day of Oct. 23rd, 2009.

Watsonville Health Center: Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8am to 4:30pm and
9 Crestview Dr. Tuesday and Thursday from 8am to 7:30pm.
Closed weekends, holidays and on the Furlough day of Oct. 23, 2009.

H1N1 LAIV is reserved for the following groups:

- Healthy persons age 2 through 24 years. Two doses are recommended for children under the age of 10.
- Household/caregivers, **age 49 and under**, of infants younger than 6 months of age.
- Health care workers and emergency medical personnel, **age 49 and under**.
