### A. Detailed Delegation Statement

The Presidential authority to negotiate indirect rates delegated to the Senior Vice President—Business and Finance by Presidential Delegation DA 2040, March 10, 1995, carries with it the authority to approve exceptions to those rates. The Executive Vice Chancellor is delegated the authority to approve all categories of indirect cost waiver or reduction requests prior to submission to the Senior Vice President.
